



Is a Consortium Agreement right for me?

1. Are you registered for at least 6 credits at Simpson University in a degree seeking program during the term you would like to pursue a consortium?
 - **Yes:** a consortium agreement might be right for you (**Continue to #2**)
 - **No:** a consortium agreement is **NOT** right for you
 - You must be enrolled in at least 6 credits at Simpson University to be eligible for a consortium agreement
2. Are the credits you are taking at your secondary school applicable to unmet degree requirements you are pursuing at Simpson University?
 - **Yes:** a consortium agreement might be right for you (**Continue to #3**)
 - **No:** a consortium agreement is **NOT** right for you
 - You must be attending credits that are applicable to the degree you are pursuing at Simpson University to be eligible for a consortium agreement
3. Are you enrolled in a self-paced course at your secondary school?
 - **No:** a consortium agreement might be right for you (**Continue to #4**)
 - **Yes:** A consortium agreement is **NOT** right for you
 - Simpson University does not process consortium agreements for self-paced courses at other institutions.
4. Are you registered for or are you planning to register full-time (UG: 12+ credits a semester; ASPIRE: 27 credits (16 month program) or 24 credits (12 month program) a financial aid year) at Simpson University?
 - **No:** a consortium agreement might be right for you (**Continue to #5**)
 - **Yes:** a consortium agreement is **NOT** right for you
 - If you are already registered full time or planning to register in full time credits for each term of enrollment at Simpson University, then you have already received the maximum amount of financial aid you are eligible to receive and a consortium agreement will not increase your current financial aid eligibility
5. Have you paid in full for your courses at your secondary school of attendance?
 - **Yes:** a consortium agreement might be right for you (**Continue to #5**)
 - **No:** You must pay in full for your courses at you secondary school of attendance and be able to provide proof of that payment to Simpson University to be eligible for a consortium agreement
