Music Major & Minor Scholarships

Students do not need an audition to be music major or minor, but they do need to audition if they would like to apply for a music scholarship.

1. Music Student Scholarship

- Submit scholarship application
- Submit two references
- Submit repertoire list
- Perform two pieces of contrasting genres
