



The Process

Each fall, we invite students to join a **WorldSERVE Team** which takes them on a year-long discipleship journey including a short-term service project the following spring or summer. Our main objective for all students participating on a WorldSERVE Team is that they would BE DISCIPLED in order to MAKE DISCIPLES.

Our team members first commit to being disciplined through a semester of intensive training, mentoring, team building and preparation. Then, they are sent around the country and globe, joining with God to *make* disciples as they partner with long-term workers in sharing the gospel, praying for the lost, caring for the poor, and furthering God's plan of redemption for the nations.

2018 WorldSERVE Locations

Spring Break 2018

- Chicago: (March 24 – April 1, 2018)
 - Envision Site with Family Empowerment Center. The main focus is on inner-city youth through an after-school program, as well as community outreaches.
- Hurricane Relief: (March 24 – April 1, 2018)
 - Students will serve in a region that has been devastated by the 2017 Hurricane season. They will partner with long-term workers and serve in the rebuilding efforts.

Summer 2018

- Albania (May – June, 2018)
 - Engage in spiritual conversations over coffee as you share the Gospel with university students and young adults. God is working in this nation that has 6 weeks.
- El Salvador (May, 2018)
 - Envision site. In partnership with local believers, you will participate in outreach to local youth, discipleship, and exposure to Salvadoran ministries. 3 weeks.
- Guinea (May – June, 2018)
 - Envision site. Join this team as they connect with La Zone, a youth center in Guinea, by teaching English, various classes, and sports in order to build relationships. 6 weeks.
- Laos (May – June, 2018)
 - In partnership with by Dr. Stephen Bailey. Emphasis on teaching English and partnering with the local church to meet with and disciple new believers. 6 weeks.
- India – School of Nursing (May – June, 2018)
 - Students from the nursing program who will have the unique opportunity to partner with a medical ministry that provides high quality medical care to rural India. 2.5 weeks.
- Taiwan (May, 2018)
 - Envision site. Emphasis on business and the mission field. Partnership with a local coffee shop in utilizing practical ministry skills, as well as partaking in the vision of planting a church among the culture. 2.5 weeks.
- Thailand (May, 2018)
 - Envision site. Emphasis on building relationships with fellow university students through spending time developing relationships. Connect with new believers and help disciple them. 3 weeks.
