

Simpson University has two undergraduate schools: Traditional Undergraduate (TUG), and the degree completion program ASPIRE.

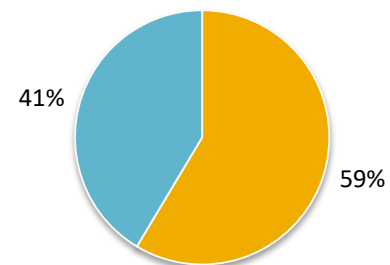

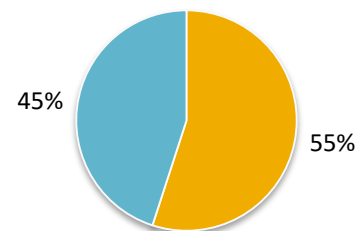
### TUG: Admissions Type
