

Bethel Student Scholarship Guidelines

Allow 7 – 10 business days for processing

Application Process

- Students who are U.S. Citizens or permanent residents must file a FAFSA (<https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>) and select Simpson as school of choice (00129100). International students do not need to file a FAFSA. International students have an additional application process and should contact the Financial Aid Office at financialaid@simpsonu.edu.
- Final eligibility for the Bethel Student Scholarship will be determined after the student's financial aid file has been completed and reviewed. It is advised that a student complete the Simpson application and pay the deposit as soon as possible, to receive the financial award letter in a timely fashion.
- Completed applications and deposits are due by the application deadline.
- Applications should be turned in as soon as possible due to limited availability.
- Applications are considered in the order that they are received. Funds are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Scholarship Terms

- The Bethel Student Scholarship is \$13,000/yr for all eligible full-time undergraduate students. There is an additional \$2,000/yr need-based scholarship for eligible students.
- Students must demonstrate need as determined by federal methodology. The scholarship will be coordinated with other need-based financial aid.
- The full amount of the Bethel Student Scholarship is available to undergraduate students only.
- There is a portion of the Bethel Student scholarship that will be available to graduate and Tozer Seminary students. This amount can be up to \$2,000 per program, subject to availability.
- The scholarship may only be applied towards on-campus tuition, class fees, room, and board.

Other Scholarship Details

- The Bethel Student Scholarship is designed to be a student's main source of institutional aid. On a student's award letter it will list any institutional aid they will be eligible for (academic, talent, need, etc.). The Bethel Student Scholarship will then be listed on the award letter to top up the institutional aid to either \$13,000 or \$15,000. For example, if a student had \$7,500 in academic and need aid, the Bethel Student Scholarship would be listed as \$5,500 or \$7,500 to top up the aid to the total Bethel Student Scholarship amount.
- If a student has an outstanding talent (academic, athletics, music, etc.), they may be eligible for additional scholarships and institutional aid. Students with outstanding talent should email Financial Aid at financialaid@simpsonu.edu with more details.
