

# WELCOME TO SU HOUSING



We are excited that you've chosen to attend Simpson University! We believe that the educational experience is enhanced by community, formed when living on campus. We are an intentionally residential campus, with a housing model that reflects the needs of our students. All full-time, unmarried, undergraduate students 23-years-old and under are required to live on campus.

## HOUSING OPTIONS

### ➔ On campus housing

**First-time, freshman residence halls:** Our freshman students can live in one of two residence halls: **Thompson-Mangham** for men and **Irwin-Shellrude** for women. Our first-time students can expect a vibrant community, programming and relational connection within their living area.

**Transfer students:** Students who transfer from another university may have the opportunity to live in one of the upperclassmen residence halls. We purposefully hold a number of beds within our upperclassmen living areas so that transfers can be in community with older students and experience programming and mentoring designed with them in mind.

### ➔ Off campus housing

**Off campus housing:** Students looking for an exemption to live off campus must first complete the **Off Campus Housing Exemption Application** and gain approval. Approved qualifications include:

- Being 24 years of age or older
- Living with a parent (35 miles or less from campus) - verification required
- Living at Gatehouse - an intentional living-learning environment for international students and children of missionaries or pastors
- Being a Veteran, married, having a live-in work requirement, or owning a home
- Being a part-time student

## HOW TO APPLY:

- 1 Log into the SU student portal at: <https://my.simpsonu.edu/dashboard>
- 2 Use your Simpson username & password & click on "My Housing"
- 3 Select the application you wish to complete:
  - On Campus Fall 2024 (new student)
  - Exemption to Live Off Fall 2024
- 4 Complete the application questions, then click Save and Continue Application
- 5 Review the Application Overview, and accept the Terms & Conditions & Information Disclosure agreements - then SUBMIT

When applying, students may select their room preference and a meal plan option.

## COMMON QUESTIONS: ?

### Can I choose my roommates?

Yes, you can choose up to 3 other people to live with. In order to make an official request, make sure you:

- Select Roommate Groups (from lefthand menu bar on your housing portal)
- Click Create new roommate group
- Make a group name
- Write in the Simpson email of the person/people you'd like to room with

*\*\*The person/people you're requesting must also have applied for housing and confirm the invitation from you to join their roommate group.*

### If I commute, can I eat in the cafeteria?

YES! All you need to do is email [reslife@simpsonu.edu](mailto:reslife@simpsonu.edu) to ask for a commuter meal plan. The 2024-25 commuter rate is \$2,125 per semester.
