

## Calculate Your Grade Point Average for Simpson University Nursing Prerequisites

Admission into Simpson University's Nursing Program is based off a point system. Students earn points from their personal statement, ATI TEAS score, recommendation forms, their cumulative grade point average (GPA) and their prerequisite GPA. This calculation only includes courses that transfer to Simpson University. This calculation may be different from the GPA calculation generated by the nursing committee.

This worksheet will help you calculate your nursing prerequisite. If you repeat a course, only the highest grade will be calculated into the GPA. The following classes or equivalents must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. You need to enter the credits and grade earned for each course. Letter grades are given by the following points:

B = 3.0

B - = 2.7

C + = 2.3

C = 2.0

A = 3.7

B+=3.3

A + = 4.3

A = 4.0
